

**The basic groups: Pairs:**

- SET 1 - 1 2 4 3 : 4 3 1 2 : 2 1 3 4 : 3 4 2 1
- SET 2 - 1 3 4 2 : 4 2 1 3 : 3 1 2 4 : 2 4 3 1
- SET 3 - 2 3 4 1 : 4 1 2 3 : 3 2 1 4 : 1 4 3 2

**On 1 string : Level 1**- each group within the set x 2 with a pause between groups. **Level 2** - each group x 1 continuous.

**EXAMPLE:**

||: 1 2 4 3 4 3 1 2 2 1 3 4 3 4 2 1 :||

Then work across the strings with each group.

**Advanced** : split the group across the strings :

<b>STRING</b>	6	5	4	3	2	1
<b>FINGERS</b>	1 2	4 3	1 2	4 3	1 2	4 3

**COMBINING UPWARD AND DOWNWARD SLURS**

Groups - 1 2 1 : 2 3 2 : 3 4 3

**RHYTHM :**



Combine the groups on 1 string.

||: 1 2 1 2 3 2 3 4 3 2 3 2 :|| and ||: 2 1 2 3 2 3 4 3 4 3 2 3 :||

Advanced - combine the groups alternating strings

**EXAMPLE : STRINGS**                    6        5        4        3        2        1  
**GROUPS**                            1 2 1    2 3 2    1 2 1    2 3 2    1 2 1    2 3 2

**Slurs of 3 notes together** - 4 groups here - 1 2 3 : 3 2 1 : 2 3 4 : 4 3 2

**Level 1 Combinations -**

same direction ||: 1 2 3 2 3 4 :||: 2 3 4 1 2 3 :||: 4 3 2 3 2 1 :||: 3 2 1 4 3 2 :||

changing direction ||: 1 2 3 4 3 2 :||: 4 3 2 1 2 3 :||: 3 2 1 2 3 4 :||: 2 3 4 3 2 1 :||

**Level 2 - crossing strings**

**D) Groups of 4** - upward and downward within one slur.

||: 1 2 4 3 :||: 1 3 4 2 :||: 4 3 1 2 :||: 4 2 1 3 :||
